

Key to Platygastroid Genera

1. Metasoma with narrow laterotergites closely attached to sternites to form an impressed submarginal ridge (Fig. 1) **Gryon**
- Metasoma with wide laterotergites loosely attached to sternites, hence no impressed submarginal ridge (Fig. 2) **2**
2. Frons with central keel and well developed striae radiating from mandibles (Fig. 3)..... **Psix**
- Frons without central keel or striae radiating from mandibles (Figs 4-5) **3**
3. Frons predominantly smooth and shining, without sculpture, particularly in lower half (Fig. 5); T2 distinctly longer than wide (Fig. 7); notaulus absent (Fig. 7); antennal clava 4 segmented (Fig. 8) **Telenomus**
- Frons predominantly or entirely sculptured, particularly in lower half (Fig. 4); T2 wider than long (Fig. 6); notaulus often present (Fig. 6); antennal clava 5 segmented (Fig. 9) **Trissolcus**
